This program will highlight opportunities for using evidence-based practices and research findings that may impact quality of life and care outcomes for people with Parkinson's disease and dementia. Speakers will examine techniques to facilitate application of evidenced-based interventions/programs regarding Parkinson's disease and dementia and general care practices within the long-term care/continuing care retirement community setting. Basic leadership skills and their applicability to the individual's work setting will be identified.
